

## Base Metal Prices Continue to Surge as Gold Falls Below \$1,200 per Ounce


Contrasting fortunes between the precious metals and base metals space continued this week, with gold falling below the psychological \$1,200 per ounce level for the first time since February as continued commentary made the prospect of a U.S. interest rate hike in December appear more certain than ever. The price of gold has fallen almost 10% in two weeks since the unexpected U.S. election result, while gold mining equities have struggled under the weight of the falling gold price, with the S&P/TSX Global Gold index falling almost 20% since the election. This week, gold fell 2% while the index was down 4%. Silver (down 0.2%) and platinum (down 1.5%) followed suit, while palladium continued to move in the opposite direction, rising 2.6% this week. In contrast, the promise of greater infrastructure spending has continued to boost the fortunes of base metals, with copper continuing its recent surge, up another 7.7% this week, while nickel also rose a healthy 6.2%; lead (up 11%) and zinc (up 10%) prices have followed suit, spurred further by the recent closure of a number of lead/zinc mines including Century and Black Star (Australia), Lisheen (Ireland) and Brunswick and Perseverance (Canada). The S&P/TSX Composite index rose earlier in the week before levelling off after Wednesday, finishing at 15,075 (up 1.4%). Meanwhile, the S&P/TSX Venture Composite index continued to fall, down 1.7% and finishing at 735. WTI Crude prices were down this week, finishing at \$46 per barrel. Finally, the UxC weekly spot price for uranium remained flat for the week amid the news of another earthquake and tsunami warning in Japan, finishing at \$18.50 per pound.

### Macroeconomic News

**United States:** The week started on a positive note with existing home sales for October rising to their highest level in more than 9-1/2 years amid pent-up demand, offering more evidence of a pickup in economic growth in the fourth quarter, but a recent surge in mortgage rates could slow housing market activity. The National Association of Realtors said on Tuesday existing home sales increased 2.0 per cent to an annual rate of 5.6 million units last month, the highest level since February 2007. In contrast, new home sales unexpectedly fell in October, but this is likely a temporary setback for the new housing market against the backdrop of a strong labour market. The Commerce Department said on Wednesday new home sales declined 1.9% to a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 563,000 units last month. Meanwhile, the potential for higher mortgage rates appears to have caused a rush on mortgages applications, which registered a 5.5% gain on a seasonally adjusted basis last week versus the previous week, according to the Mortgage Bankers Association. Volume was nearly 10% higher than the same week one year ago. Positive news for Durable Orders, which rose 4.8% in Oct versus the 1.5% increase expected, driven by rising demand for machinery and a range of other equipment, the latest indication of an acceleration in economic growth early in Q4. Initial jobless claims rose in the week ended November 19 to a seasonally adjusted 251,000, the Labor Department said Wednesday. Economists had expected 248,000 new claims. The Markit flash reading of the US manufacturing sector came in stronger than expected for the month of November at 53.9. The Markit purchasing managers index (PMI) was projected to come in at 53.4 by economists, the same number as October. Part of the reason according to Chris Williamson, the chief business economist at Markit, was the end of the US presidential election. "US manufacturers enjoyed a strong post-election bounce in November, further tilting the scales toward the Fed hiking rates in December," said Williamson in the release. "Many factories reported that demand from customers had picked up as uncertainty about the election result cleared." This was supported by a rise in consumer sentiment; The Index of Consumer Sentiment hit 93.8 in November's final reading while economists expected 91.6. Finally, Wholesale inventories for October were estimated at an end-of-month level of \$586.9 billion seasonally adjusted, down 0.4% from September 2016, and were down 0.5% from October 2015.

##### [K92 Mining Inc. \(KNT-V, \\$0.92\) – Site Visit: Significant Progress Made at Irumafimpa as K92 Eyes 2017 Mine Restart](#)

We recently visited K92 Mining's 100% owned Kainantu gold project in the Eastern Highlands province of Papua New Guinea. The Company acquired the project from Barrick Gold (ABX-T, Buy Rating, \$37.50 TP) in 2015 for an initial cash payment of US\$2 million and the potential payment of up to an additional US\$60 million based on future gold production. The acquisition comprised a processing facility (including crushers, mill, and flotation tanks), tailings dam, ancillary equipment and facilities, and a fully functional camp and office buildings.

We note that Barrick initially bought the project from Highland Pacific for US\$141 million, and spent more than US\$100 million on underground development, exploration, and definition drilling, and construction of additional infrastructure. Both Highland and Barrick produced 68,593 ounces of gold grading 6.94 g/t between 2006 and 2008 before Barrick put the mine on care and maintenance in 2009.

Since acquiring the project in 2015, K92 Mining's primary focus has been on restarting mine operations at Irumafimpa (targeting Q1/17); the task includes refurbishment of the current processing facility (e.g., installation of a drum scrubber for processing wet ore) and rehabilitation of underground workings (e.g., rock bolts and meshing). The Company also recently began processing remnant ore (~60,000 tonnes) not processed when the Irumafimpa mine was put on care and maintenance in 2009.

##### [Kootenay Silver Inc. \(KTN-V, \\$0.36\) – Drilling at Ram Target Intersects Silver Mineralization over 400 metres of Strike](#)

Kootenay Silver released results today from 11 drill holes at the 'Ram' target, located on its 100%-owned La Cigarra project near Parral City, Chihuahua, Mexico.

Kootenay completed the acquisition of the La Cigarra project with its acquisition of Northair Silver in late April 2016. The Ram target is comprised of 3,800 metres of interpreted north/south trending strike, with today's results covering ~400 metres of the northern portion of the strike length. The Ram target sits ~700 metres to the south / west of the La Cigarra deposit (Exhibit 4; 'all-categories' resource of 62.9 million ounces of silver; avg. grade of 85 g/t silver; 82% Measured & Indicated, with lower-grade zinc (90 Mlb), lead (67 Mlb) and gold (49 koz)).

Within today's results there are some very promising higher-grade intersections (see below) among the mineralized intervals that suggest the potential for the Ram target to host a material silver resource proximal to the La Cigarra deposit, which is promising and could be complimentary. Intersecting some degree of silver mineralization in 9 of 11 holes is a good hit rate (82%) for a first pass drill program of



fairly wide spaced (often) pairs of holes. As shown in Exhibit 1, the two holes that did not intersect mineralization are both collared approximately 100-150 metres to the west of the balance of the holes.

#### Midas Gold Corp. (MAX-T, \$0.96) – Initial Yellow Pine Infill Drilling Yields Augmentative High-Grade Gold Mineralization

Yellow Pine Exploration: The initial batch of drill results on Yellow Pine, the likely focus of initial open pit mining for the Stibnite Gold project, unearthed high-grade gold mineralization in the northern, down-dip, portion of the deposit. Two holes encountered shallow high-grade gold mineralization (MGI-16-411: 35.2 metres grading 3.1 g/t gold from a down hole depth of 118.7 metres, and MGI-16-412: 22.9 metres grading 4.7 g/t gold from a down hole depth of 88.8 metres) in which intersected mineralized intervals are estimated to be close to true width.

These two drill holes sought to test an information gap in the drill dataset that geologically is interpreted to represent a portion of a northeast-trending structure with a steep dip and a width of 25-50 metres. The linear structure was termed the Hidden Fault Zone after its intersection during 2012 drilling. Reportedly this targeted zone was modelled in the 2014 PFS, and was included in the reserve pit as inferred resources grading 1.3 g/t gold that defaulted to waste in the mine plan.

#### Nevsun Resources Ltd. (NSU-T, \$4.38) – Bisha Metallurgy ...Light at the End of the Tunnel(?)


We recently returned from a site tour of Nevsun's 60% owned Bisha copper-zinc mine in Eritrea (northeast Africa). Overall the project shows well. Our focus was on clarity pertaining to ramp-up issues encountered to date in Bisha's (new) primary copper circuit, which due to metallurgical issues, has been producing a 'bulk' concentrate product, which although saleable (to zinc customers), is garnering 'discounted' economics (relative to a 'standard' copper concentrate product as planned/envisioned at Bisha). Progress to date lends confidence that the core issue(s) has been identified. Although not completely solved, we anticipate Bisha's primary copper circuit metallurgical issues will be addressed by Q1/17 (noting 'commercial' primary production was declared as of October 1, 2016). Nevertheless, investor patience is required in the meantime as (near-term) metallurgical uncertainty continues to garner market scrutiny.





### Silver - 1-Year US\$/oz (left) and Total ETF Holdings (right)





### Platinum - 1-Year US\$/oz (left) and Total ETF Holdings (right)





### Palladium - 1-Year US\$/oz (left) and Total ETF Holdings (right)










## Lead - 1-Year US\$/lb (left) and LME Inventory (right)




## Zinc - 1-Year US\$/lb (left) and LME Inventory (right)
