
Precious/Base Metals Rally Continues

It was a positive week for precious and base metals, with most of the key metals experiences significant gains. Today saw the price of gold rise to US\$1,325 per ounce (up 2.57%) after weaker-than-expected jobs figures in the U.S.; the late week rise saw gold post its biggest gain since January and break through the US\$1,300 per ounce level for the first time since November last year. Another milestone was set for platinum (up 3.25%), which pierced the \$1,000 per ounce level for the first time since February, while silver (up 3.60%) and palladium (up 5.44%) also finished the week stronger. Platinum, palladium and silver each finished at US\$1,007, US\$982 and US\$17.70 per ounce respectively at close on Friday. Base metals also fared well this week, continuing their upward trend that has now seen copper (up 2.29%) rise to its highest level in almost 3 years, fueled by forecasts of strong demand in top copper consumer China and falling inventories; meanwhile, nickel (up 4.57%), lead (up 2.87%) and zinc (up 4.07%) each recorded gains to finish at US\$5.43, US\$1.07 and US\$1.44 per pound respectively. As expected, the rise in metal prices translated to gains in mining equities, with both the S&P/TSX Global Gold and Global Base Metals Index rising by 10.03 points and 3.98 points respectively; junior miners also enjoyed a positive week as indicated by the GDXJ Index, however the S&P/TSX Venture Index response was more muted, rising only 8.98 points for the week. With the recent surge in commodity prices over the last few weeks, we expect mining and exploration equities to continue to perform positively, especially after the summer. Finally, WTI crude prices fell early in the week before rebounding on Friday to finish 1.16% down at US\$47 per barrel; approximately a quarter of the U.S. refining industry has reportedly been affected by the flooding caused by Hurricane Harvey this week, with some commentators expecting the markets to be affected by the disaster to last for months.

Metals Sector Macro

Macroeconomic News

United States

On Monday, it was announced that preliminary <u>Wholesale Inventories</u> rose 0.4% in July to US\$601.2 billion in a constructive build for Q3 gross domestic product (GDP) that offsets the 0.2% decline in preliminary retail inventories and beats surveyed expectations of a 0.3% increase.

Following July's increase, the <u>Conference Board Consumer Confidence Index</u> improved further in August. The Index now stands at 122.9, up from 120.0 in July. August's result is the best since March's 124.9 and is the second highest since December 2000. The Present Situation Index increased from 145.4 to 151.2, while the Expectations Index rose from 103.0 last month to 104.0.

According to the Mortgage Bankers Association (MBA), <u>mortgage applications</u> fell 2.3% in the week ended August 25, after the prior week's 0.5% decrease. Refinancing applications fell 2.0%, while applications to purchase a home fell by a seasonally adjusted 2.7%. The average fixed 30-year mortgage rate fell by 1 basis point (bps) to 4.11%.

<u>ADP Employment</u> increased by 237,000 workers in August, the most in 5 months and beating market expectations of 185,000. The service-providing sector added 204,000 jobs, led by trade, transportation, and utilities, which increased by 56,000. However, job losses occurred in the information sector, which decreased by 3,000. The goods-producing sector added 33,000 jobs owing to construction (up 18,000) and manufacturing (up 16,000). Of August's increase, large companies were the ones hiring the highest number of workers at 115,000, followed by midsized (74,000) and small firms (48,000).

The <u>U.S. GDP</u> expanded by an annualized 3% in Q2 of 2017, well above a preliminary reading of 2.6% and beating surveyed expectations of a 2.7% increase. Q2 shows the strongest growth rate since Q1 2015. Non-residential investment was positive, at a 6.9% rate, beating previous estimates. However, residential investment came it at a negative 6.5% rate following a positive 11.1% rate in Q1.

<u>Initial jobless claims</u> increased by 1,000 for the week ending August 26 and came in at 236,000, compared with consensus estimates of 238,000. The 4-week average decreased by 1,250 from the previous week's average to the 236,750 level. <u>Continuing claims</u>, where data lag by a week, came in at 1,942,000, a 12,000 decrease from the previous week's level of 1,954,000. The unemployment rate for insured workers is unchanged at a very low 1.4%.

Canada

According to Statistics Canada, Canada's economy is expanding at its fastest annualized rate in six years. Canada's <u>GDP</u> grew by an annualized rate of 4.5% in the second quarter of 2017, the highest the figure has been since the third quarter of 2011. <u>GDP Month over Month</u> increased by 0.3% in June, beating surveyed expectations of a 0.1% increase.

The Markit Canada Manufacturing PMI fell to 54.6 in August from 55.5 in July. August's reading is the lowest growth in the manufacturing sector since January. However, production and new business were robust, leading to a record high rise in employment. In addition, manufacturers' sentiment towards future output remained firmly positive in August amid upbeat sales forecasts.

<u>Ascot Resources Ltd. (AOT-V, \$1.75, [Not Rated]) – Site Visit: Ascot Prepares to Advance</u> Premier/Dilworth Project

We recently visited Ascot Resources' (AOT-V) Premier and Dilworth properties within the Golden Triangle of Northern British Columbia. Both projects are located approximately 20 kilometres south of the town of Stewart. The Company has almost completed an earn-in agreement with Boliden (BOL-STO; not rated), with a final \$15 million payment in escrow awaiting the finalization of Boliden's closure plan requirements, including the setup of ongoing monitoring of the historical tailings pond.

Highlights

We note an engineering report commissioned by the Company suggests that both can be reutilized. The tailings dam has additional capacity of up to 20 million tonnes. Key observations from the site visit include the following:

- Well Located and Nearby Key Infrastructure: 25 kV power grid and historical mine infrastructure are generally in good condition, and a tailings dam has additional capacity of up to 20 million tonnes.
- **Premier Mine Area:** This historical gold producer has a high-grade vein-controlled gold deposit occurring in multiple zones over a 1 km² area and includes bonanza grades (such as 14,304 grams per tonne [g/t] gold and 6,830 g/t silver in hole P14-707).
- **Big Missouri, Martha Ellen, Dilworth Zones:** The global (pit constrained) resource (indicated and inferred) contains 4 million ounces (Moz) of gold grading 0.73 g/t and 40 Moz of silver grading 7 g/t silver, with potential to delineate higher grade zones.
- Cashed Up with ~\$28 Million: A 120,000-metre drill programs for 2017 is focused on Premier, plus 20,000 metres are for exploration.

<u>Kootenay Silver Inc. (KTN-V, \$0.26, [Not Rated]) – Drilling at Las Venadas Extends Silver Mineralization 140 Metres to the Northeast</u>

Kootenay Silver released results on Wednesday from hole CC-17-28 at the Las Venadas target from its ongoing 7,500-metre drill program at the 100% owned La Cigarra project in the Parral mining district, Chihuahua, Mexico.

Highlights:

- Follow-up Drilling to Discovery Hole Supports Continuity of New Zone: The results from hole CC-17-28 extend the new discovery zone at Las Venadas 140 metres northeast of the initial hole CC-17-26, further supporting the potential for the Las Venadas target to host significant silver resources proximal to the La Cigarra deposit. Kootenay reports that hole CC-17-28 exhibits brecciation, veining, and alteration consistent with discovery hole CC-17-26 (see August 15 Flash) and was drilled 62 metres deeper. The results released on Wednesday represent only the upper part of the zone owing to faulted rock preventing further drilling in CC-17-28. Management believes that the stronger part of the system resides deeper than either hole as tested, given that hole CC-17-26 encountered its stronger zone toward the bottom of the intercept, and CC-17-28 was lost in faulted rock. We expect future follow-up drilling to provide further clarity on the extent of the new zone and its resource potential. The new discovery zone is located ~1,000 metres south of the La Cigarra main deposit and is part of a trend that includes distinct mineralized structures over 6.0 kilometres, containing an 'all-categories' resource of 62.9 Moz of silver; average grade of 85 g/t silver; 82% measured and indicated (M&I), with lower grade zinc (90 million pounds [Mlb]), lead (67 Mlb), and gold (49,000 ounces).
- **Upcoming Drilling to Drive News Flow:** Kootenay plans to drill a shallower hole at site CC-17-26 in order to finish testing the extent of the mineralized zone. A third intercept will help in determining the zone's shape and in designing a drill program. We anticipate news flow regarding follow-up drilling to be a catalyst for Kootenay Silver shares as the program progresses.
- La Cigarra Project and Las Venadas Target: Background: Kootenay completed the acquisition of the La Cigarra project with its acquisition of Northair Silver in late April 2016. The Las Venadas target is located ~1,000 metres south of the main La Cigarra deposit, and contains various structures with vein-breccia, veins, and veinlets over a 500- to 800-metre distance. Previous results have indicated that the strength and intensity of brecciation, veining, and alteration are "much stronger than anything observed within the La Cigarra resource itself," with individual sample grades from CC-17-26 assayed as high as 799 g/t silver (over 1.1 metres) and 692 g/t silver (over 1 metre) in discrete zones.

GT Gold Corp. (GTT-V, \$2.20, [Not Rated]) – GT Gold Releases High-Grade Results from Diamond Drilling at Saddle South

GT Gold announced drill assay results from its Saddle South target, located on the Tatogga property within the Golden Triangle in northwestern British Columbia. In total, eight diamond-drill holes were released and are presented below, and represent the first diamond holes drilled on the property.

- **Hole TTD007:** 6.95 metres grading 51.53 g/t gold and 117.38 g/t silver from a downhole depth of 122.13 metres, including 6.33 metres grading 56.22 g/t gold and 128.88 g/t silver, which included 4.39 metres grading 67.11 g/t gold and 132.76 g/t silver
- **Hole TTD001:** 7.00 metres grading 10.26 g/t gold and 46.07 g/t silver from a downhole depth of 20.00 metres, including 4.88 metres grading 14.12 g/t gold and 65.51 g/t silver, which included 2.00 metres grading 19.73 g/t gold and 152.85 g/t silver
- Hole TTD002: 14.78 metres grading 6.57 g/t gold and 121.31 g/t silver from a downhole depth of 51.22 metres, including 9.00 metres grading 9.99 g/t gold and 198.24 g/t silver, which included 1.00 metre grading 22.00 g/t gold and 440.00 g/t silver

Copper LME Inventories Fall to 12-Year Low – London Metal Exchange (LME)copper inventories had the largest weekly drop since October 2005 (-11%), while the price had a seventh weekly gain (+3%) to \$3.02/lb. In China, inventories in Shanghai also fell, and the country's refined copper imports rose in June for the third consecutive month. The regulatory environment for scrap imports could become a positive factor for demand. Nickel was up by 4.6% week over week (WoW) to \$5.18/lb, supported by increasing stainless steel demand from China. The zinc price fell back from its 10-year high, declining 2% WoW to \$1.39/lb after 4 weeks of gains. However, global zinc inventories continue to fall (-43% year to date), now below 11 days of consumption.

Strong Performance for Base Metal Equities – Sherritt International (S-T; not rated) and Capstone Mining (CS-T, Buy, TP \$1.50) were the week's best performers, up 25% and 17.7% respectively. Nevsun Resources (NSU-T, Hold, TP \$3.70) recovered from a 1.31% decline the previous week to gain 6.8% WoW. Hudbay Minerals (HBM-T, Buy, TP \$12.00) was up by another 9%, following a 10% increase the previous week.

We Remain Overweight on the Base Metals Producers – Despite strong gains since mid-June—the S&P/TSX diversified metals and mining index is up 19.8% over the past 3 months, led by HBM (+52%), CMMC (+45%), and CS (+41%)—valuations remain attractive. Base metals equities in our coverage universe currently trade at an average enterprise value to 2018 cash flow (EV/2018 CF) of 5.8x, and an enterprise value to earnings before interest, taxes, depreciation, and amortization (EV/EBITDA) of 4.7x. However, we note that analyst estimates are not reflecting the current strong price environment for the metals, with forecasts well below forward curve prices. We expect upward adjustments to consensus price forecasts to come with Q3/17, as results will highlight the reasonable valuation and the performance potential of most base metals stocks.

Atlantic Gold Corporation (AGB-V, \$1.51, [Buy Rating, \$1.80 Target Price]) – MRC Mine Eyes First Gold Production in Coming Weeks

Overall Project – The Company has reported that the final stages of commissioning are in progress. Dry and wet commissioning processes are nearly complete, and the ball mill is turning, with overall commissioning progress now at ~94%. Atlantic notes overall commissioning processes to date have revealed no significant issues. We highlight that first gold pour is projected for later in September, and such a time frame will make Atlantic's operation the next new producing gold mine in Canada.

Commissioning – The commissioning activities were initiated in late July, on the plant site receiving grid power and being energized early that month. Surface infrastructure, including the processing plant and tailings management facility, is reportedly substantially complete, with the ore stockpile pad readied with apparent access to more than 1.5 million tonnes of exposed ore that is now available for drilling and blasting within the Touqouy pit. Commissioning of the processing plant and services remains on track to meet the first gold pour timeline, as the crushing circuit was handed over to the Atlantic operations team on August 24, with load tests having commenced, the ball mill drive tested and fully commissioned, and the water load test operation now completed. Carbon in leach (CIL) gold recovery tanks have been water tested, and agitators commissioned, with a full-cycle water loop completed from the ball mill through to the process water tank. The Company reports the successful commissioning and service of process and fresh water, with process water intake, water pumping station, tailings line, and decant tower installation expected to be fully constructed by the first week of September.

Future Production Projections – We expect a prefeasibility study on the Cochrane Hill and Fifteen Mile Stream satellite deposits to be tabled in Q4/17. Given this resource update we are now projecting that Fifteen Mile Stream would likely be prioritized ahead of Cochrane Hill on grade, total contained ounces of gold, plant proximity, and likely mining strip ratio (using a 0.35 g/t gold). Considering the new resources, we integrate Fifteen Mile Stream into our production scenario starting only in 2021.

Announcement of Extension of Lenders' Waiver for Term Debt Facility

- Debt Negotiations: The Company announced an update on its ongoing negotiations with the
 debt syndicate to revise the terms of the current debt facility, including the amount of Reserve

 the recent announcement in May that extended the Cash Call Reserve Account balance

- The Company notes the updated extension provided by the lending group is a function of the strong operational performance Gacho Kué has demonstrated since the inception of commercial production in March. The revised agreement now includes a waiver that extends the debt

covenant timeline by requiring a Cash Call Reserve Account balance of US\$25 million by September 15, 2017, and the funding of the remaining reserve accounts (Sunk Cost Reserve Account of US\$44 million and Debt Service Reserve Account of US\$57 million) by November 30, 2017. The Company also notes that the revised agreement includes a limitation on the utilization of the current facility to the current outstanding principal balance of US\$357 million, leaving an undrawn portion of US\$13 million.

• In June, the Company provided its quarterly interest payment of US\$6.5 million from cash flows rather than drawing from the debt facility. Mountain Province has noted it anticipates using cash flows also to meet the upcoming quarterly interest payment due in September. Additionally, as a condition of the revised waiver agreement, an updated financial model and life-of-mine plan are to be delivered to the lending group by November 30, 2017.

Acquisition for minor-moderate equity dilution adds to mid-term production pipeline potential for likely development post the completion of the Ity CIL project.

Highlights:

- Endeavour-Avnel All-Share Deal Accepted as in accordance with the scheme of arrangement, greater than 75% of Avnel shareholders voted in favour of the deal. 88.9% of scheme shareholders voted in favour and completion of the scheme remains subject to the sanction by the Royal Court of Guersney on September 14th. Upon receipt of sanction by the Court, Avnel anticipates the scheme will be completed on September 18th, 2017 with trading of Avnel shares expected to be halted at the close of trading on September 15th. Avnel shareholders will receive 0.0187 shares in Endeavour for each share in the target company. Endeavour will issue approximately 7 million shares, following the transaction Endeavour will have approximately 104 million ordinary share issues, with former Avnel shareholders holding approximately 7% of Endeavour's pro forma share capital.
- Target Assets The Malian assets include the 80% owned Kalana project with 2P reserves outlined at 21.7 Mt grading 2.8 g/t gold containing 1.964 Moz gold. The 2016 Kalana Project DFS highlights an after-tax NPV8% (100% basis) of US\$196 million (at US\$1,200/oz gold) and considers an 18 year mine-life producing ~101 koz gold per annum at an AISC of US\$784/oz. Initial development CAPEX is estimated at US\$196 million.
- Maturation of Mid-Term Value Potential On completion of the deal, Endeavour notes that they aim to redesign and optimize of the prevailing Kalana DFS to potentially lift plant capacity, as well as initiate exploration on proximal mine targets. Given Endeavour's current development pipeline (e.g., Houndé and Ity CIL), a potential Kalana production scenario could represent a mid-term opportunity (2021) whereby such timing could form a segue in Malian production from Tabakoto (depending on prevailing exploration success) to Kalana. We see the possible value addition for Endeavour Mining being the demonstration of organic growth potential through exploration activities proximal to Kalana, as well as the delivery of an optimized study on Kalana that heightens gold production rates.

We are discontinuing coverage of Avnel Gold Mining following the recent acquisition by Endeavour Mining (EDV-T, Buy, \$35.00 target) and the announcement that the Company had received the requisite shareholder approvals. Endeavour Mining acquired Avnel Gold for US\$122M (C\$159M, or C\$0.42/sh) in an all-share transaction. Although we believe that Avnel is not fully realizing on the potential of the Kalana gold deposit as a result of the transaction, the premium is reasonable, and Endeavour will add value to the project. Endeavour payed a premium of 48% to the closing price of Avnel's shares on June 28 (at the time of the offer), and a premium of 52% to Avnel's 20-day VWAP.

Barkerville announced additional drilling results from its ongoing 130,000-metre Phase II program at its Caribou project in British Columbia. The latest results are primarily from the Shaft Zone (situated at Island Mountain), where combined with the Valley Zone, the Company is currently exploring and delineating with eight drill rigs. The Company has a ninth drill rig testing a broad gold-in-soil anomaly on Barkerville Mountain, and a tenth drill rig expanding the known mineralization on the BC Vein. This drilling has extended mineralization to the south and at depth. The holes targeted portions of the 2015 mineral resource classified as inferred or waste, and below the 2015 pit outline. Drill hole 137A was located outside known mineralization and returned 0.38 g/t gold over 83.8 metres, including 1.84 g/t gold over 6.1 metres, and several drill holes returned mineralization below the 2015 modelled pit shell. <u>Trek Mining Inc. (TREK-V, \$1.08, [Buy Rating, \$3.00 Target Price]) – Q2 Results Out – Well Cashed Up and Koricancha Mill Continues Ramping Up</u>

Q2/17 Financials Released – During Q2/17, Trek reported revenue of US\$3.2 million from the sale of 2,545 ounces of gold, up from US\$2.6 million from the sale of 2,117 ounces of gold from Koricancha in Q1/17. Trek holds a 75% interest in the Koricancha mill (and an 8% royalty on cost of goods sold) which processes ore purchased from small-scale artisanal miners throughout Peru. Operating activities resumed in Q4/16, and the mill continues its gradual ramp-up to its processing capacity of 350 tonnes per day. The operation is now near breakeven, generating a US\$0.4 million EBITDA loss in Q2. Third-party purchased ores continue to increase, with 5,662 tonnes purchased in Q2, up from 3,524 tonnes in Q1, and recovered grade was 0.45 ounces per tonne (opt) in Q2, versus 0.6 opt in Q1. During the quarter, Trek 's cash balance declined to US\$69 million, down from US\$80 million at the end of Q1/17, owing to care and maintenance costs at Aurizona, exploration, general and administrative (G&A) expense, and operating costs at Koricancha.

Feasibility Study Delivers a Strong IRR with Reasonable Capex — During Q2, Trek announced the results of an updated feasibility study (FS) for its 100% owned Aurizona gold mine located in northeastern Brazil. Most metrics came in line with our expectations, while capital costs were lower than we were modelling (US\$131 million versus US\$175), and operating costs were higher (US\$691/oz versus US\$600/oz). Capex was US\$15 million lower with the move to contract mining. The feasibility highlighted similar economics to the last FS, delivering average annual production of 136,000 ounces of gold over a 6.5-year mine life, an after-tax net present value (NPV)5% of US\$197 million at a





US\$1,250/oz gold price assumption and an after-tax internal rate of return (IRR) of 34%. The FS was prepared by Lycopodium Minerals Canada, which has a lot of experience in engineering plants of this size. Trek will now focus on engineering, procurement, and construction management activities and has awarded this project EPCM work to Ausenco Engineering Canada.

Trevali announced it has closed the acquisition of the Rosh Pinah and Perkoa zinc mines from Glencore for a purchase price of \$418M. The Company has also closed the \$190M debt facility.


Highlights:

- Transformative Deal The acquisition of the Rosh Pina and Perkoa mines more than doubles annual zinc production for Trevali from approximately 160 Mlbs to over 400 Mlbs. The transaction is accretive to our NAV, and improves cash flow by 317% over \$59M in 2016 to \$245M in 2018. In addition, we believe there is attractive growth potential within the Company's portfolio of mines and projects.
- Transaction Details In March 2017, Trevali announced the acquisition of two primary zinc mines in Africa from Glencore for \$418 M (\$245 M in cash and \$173 M in shares to Glencore). As a result of the transaction, Glencore is a 25% shareholder of the Company, with exclusive offtake agreements. As part of the deal, Trevali has closed a \$190M senior debt facility, which includes a \$160M senior secured term loan and a \$30M senior secured revolving working capital loan. Additionally, the Company has used funds from the transaction to redeem C\$53.91M in Trevali's 12.5% senior secured notes due in May 2019. With the deal now closed, cash flow from the African mines will be reflected in a working capital adjustment in the Q3/17 financial statements.
- Well Positioned to Capitalize on a Strong Zinc Price With global zinc stocks down 43% YTD, equivalent to 11 days of consumption, we believe the zinc price is well positioned for further appreciation. Among intermediate producer peers, Trevali is best positioned to benefit from appreciating zinc prices. We estimate that a 10% increase in the zinc price would equate to a 12% increase in cash flow to Trevali.




Gold - 1-Year US\$/oz (left) and Total ETF Holdings (right)














Price Chart, Rating and Target Price History (as of September 1, 2017)




















































































































